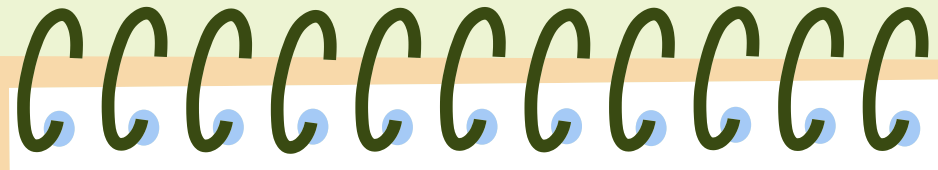


Admission Eligibility

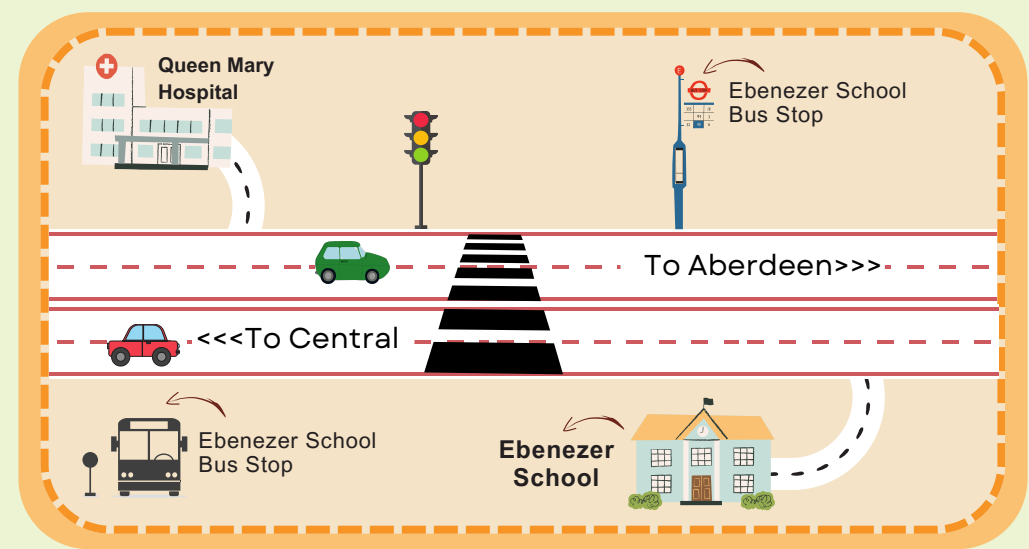


- Eligible Hong Kong resident
- Visually impaired children aged six to eighteen (moderate to severe visual impairment or total blindness)
- Moderate visual impairment: Visual acuity is 6/18 or worse, but not less than 6/60
- Severe visual impairment: Visual acuity is 6/60 or worse, but not less than 6/120
- Total blindness: No visual function, no light perception
- Cerebral /Cortical visual impairment

Referral and assessment by the Education Bureau are required (For details, please contact the Education Bureau Special Education Support Team 2 at 3698-3727)

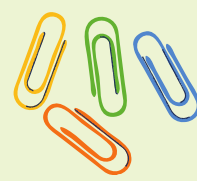
EBENEZER SCHOOL



Overview

Established in 1956, Ebenezer School is the only school for visually impaired students in Hong Kong that provides both mainstream and adapted curriculum for primary and secondary education, as well as other learning experiences and rehabilitation training. We tailor individual learning plans for students to help them learn happily and effectively, developing their multiple intelligences. We also offer boarding services for students in need. Upon completion of junior secondary education, students can choose to continue their studies at Ebenezer School or transfer to other mainstream schools for senior secondary education. Senior secondary students attending mainstream schools can concurrently participate in the 'Resource Support Programme' (RSP) and receive professional assistance and support from us.

The school has classrooms for students from P. 1 to S. 6 as well as special rooms including a swimming pool, gymnasium, music room, visual arts room, laboratory, computer room, STEAM room, campus TV station, Technology & Living room, Low Vision training room, CVI training room, play therapy room, occupational therapy room, speech therapy room, sensory-motor training room, library, career guidance room, the Artistry, Dark Experience room and Tactile Art Gallery.



Rehabilitation Training and Therapy

In addition to academic knowledge, the school also prioritizes the rehabilitation needs of students. The school integrates rehabilitation into education to enhance the efficacy of learning and teaching. School-based rehabilitation training includes orientation and mobility training (O&M), low vision (LV) and braille training, while therapeutic training includes speech, occupational, and physical therapy.

Career & Life Planning

Our school provides career life planning education, which cultivates students' self-awareness, personal planning, goal-setting, reflection abilities, and understanding of various pathways to further education, employment and training, as well as information about the workplace. Additionally, our school arranges internship opportunities according to students' abilities through collaborations with the government, other non-profit and commercial organizations.



Boarding Service



The school provides residential services offering accommodation and nursing services to boarders. It aligns with daily routines by providing training in self-care, rehabilitation, household skills, etc., fostering independent living skills. Additionally, the dormitory offers various programmes to enable boarders to experience a fulfilling communal life.
