<u>Report</u> on the Use of the One-off Grant for Supporting the Implementation of the Senior Secondary Subject Citizenship and Social Development Grant (23-24)

First, \$13,255 was spent on purchasing learning and teaching materials (books / eLearning resources). Second, another \$600 was spent on organising school-based learning activities relating to the Citizenship and Social Development (CS) curriculum. Finally, \$105,845 was spent on Mainland interflow activities or study tours relating to the CS curriculum (5-day Chengdu study tour).

The unspent balance for the year is \$161,300.

<u>Plan</u> on the Use of the One-off Grant for Supporting the Implementation of the Senior Secondary Subject Citizenship and Social Development Grant (24-25)

First, \$10,000 is planned for purchasing learning and teaching materials (books / eLearning resources). Second, another \$10,000 planned for organising school-based learning activities relating to the CS curriculum. Third, \$141,300 planned for subsidising students who study CS and teachers to participate in Mainland interflow activities or study tours relating to the CS curriculum (5-day Guangzhou study tour).

The estimate total expenditure for the year 24-25 is \$161,300.
